Let's Rock!!! Materials List

For all those little rock stars in your life! Finally a quilt for those more spunky kids who want a garage band one day. Perfect for boys or girls! Or maybe the rock star is you?! Can't you just see this quilt in pinks and browns? Have fun and enjoy making this quilt!

Fabric: All fabrics used are 44"/45" wide

- 1 bundle of at least 32 - 9"x 10 1/2" precut blocks (this is what gives you the huge variety of patterns on the quilt w/o buying yardage).
- 2/3 yd. for stars, lightning bolts, stripes, binding and circles
- 7/8 yd. polka dot fabric for stripes, binding, rectangles and circles
- 1 1/2 yds. for the background, stripes and lightning bolt rows
- 3/8 yd. for the guitar, something contrasting from the background
- 3/4 yds. for the backing and binding
- 59"x61" piece of batting (like "Warm and Natural" or similar)

Trim:

- 3 yds. of mini ric rac for the guitar strings (it's about 1/4" wide)
- 1 1/2 yds. of JUMBO ric rac for the polka dot stripe
- 1 1/2 yds. of one color of 1/2" wide ric rac for one of the stripes
- 1 1/2 yds. of a second color of 1/2" wide ric rac for the other stripe

Other Supplies:

- 1 bundle of DMC embroidery floss in a contrasting color from the background fabric for the words and shooting star tails
- 1 Large eye needle for hand sewing the words and star tails
- 3 or 4 small spools of thread in different colors for the appliquéing
- 1 spool of thread for all of the sewing
- 1 1/2 yds. of Light iron on fusible webbing for the appliquéing
