

## fresh picked™ Pincushions

Add some sweetness to your sewing studio with a fruit salad of pincushions - five designs included. Fresh Picked pincushions can be used as decorations, ornaments or sachets - and they make great presents too!

## MATERIALS LIST

## PEAR, APPLE OR TOMATO†

- 8" w x 8" h fabric\*
- 8" w x 8" h contrast fabric\*
- 16" w x 8" h light-weight, fusible, woven interfacing
- Wool or wool-blend felt scraps for leaves & stems
- Embroidery thread for leaf veins (pear & apple only)
- Doll-maker's needle (apple & tomato only)
- Two 3/4" + buttons (tomato only)
- Stuffing\*\*
- Thread

## STRAWBERRY (small or large)

- 8" w x 5" h fabric\*
- Wool or wool-blend felt scraps for leaves & optional flower
- Embroidery thread for seeds & flower center
- 1/4 yd ribbon, 1/8"-3/8" wide (loop option)
- Fabric glue
- Stuffing\*\*
- Thread

## HELPFUL TOOLS

Pins, scissors, iron, hand-sewing needles, seam ripper, stuffing tool (Stuffing Fork™, chopstick, etc.)

† Pear, apple, or tomato pincushions can be made with one fabric, with two alternating fabrics or with six different fabrics. The materials list and enclosed instructions are for pincushions made with two alternating fabrics.

\* Suitable fabrics include quilting-weight cotton, light-weight decorator fabric, corduroy, velveteen and other



light- to medium-weight woven fabrics. Wool or wool-blend felt may be used if interfaced as outlined in the pattern instructions. Do not use stretchy fabrics such as wovens with lycra content, or knits.

\*\* Stuffing options include standard polyester stuffing material, crushed walnuts, emery powder, wood shavings or a combination of these.
