

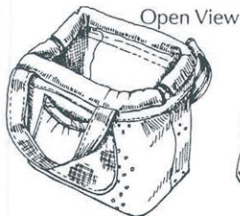
# THE CARPETBAG

These bags are made using purchased metal tubular frames. They are spring loaded so that the top "snaps" open and stays in place until being "snapped" shut. (see diagram above.) This is great for keeping the contents of your purse intact!

## MATERIALS NEEDED:

Finished Sizes: Small Bag - 9"h x 12"w; Large Bag - 12"h x 15"w

### **View 1 – Small Bag**

- 1/2 yard fabric for bag
- 1/2 yard fabric for lining and pocket lining (choose something fun – it will show on the outside)
- 1/2 yard of interlining
- Fusible fleece for straps
- Fat quarter for straps and pocket
- 1/8 yard of fabric for trim (or 2 yards purchased trim)
- Purchased 7" tubular frame\*\*

### **View 2 – Large Bag**

- 1/2 yard fabric for bag
- 1/2 yard fabric for lining (choose something fun – it will show on the outside)
- 1/5 yard for straps
- 1/2 yard of interlining such as fusible fleece
- Fusible fleece for straps
- 2 1/4 yards of trim – 3/4" wide
- Purchased 12" tubular frame\*\*
