

BEST BIAS SKIRT

The Best Bias Skirt with side slits flatters and adapts to any figure. The elastic waist and 2-piece construction help make this garment a fast and easy project. Add unique styling with either purchased or handmade bias strips in coordinating colors. Finish hem with a length of bias and add a pocket in the front or back of skirt. You are sure to make this stylish skirt many times. Sizes XS-2XL.

Materials Needed:

BOTH VIEWS:

Size S: 2 yards of 45" wide fabric, 1 5/8 yards of 60" wide fabric

Size M: 2 1/8 yards of 45" wide fabric, 1 5/8 yards of 60" wide fabric

Size L: 2 1/4 yards of 45" wide fabric, 1 3/4 yards of 60" wide fabric

Size XL: 2 3/8 yards of 45" wide fabric, 1 7/8 yards of 60" wide fabric

Size 2XL: 2 1/2 yards of 45" wide fabric, 2 yards of 60" wide fabric

For all Sizes: 2 yards of 3/4" wide elastic

BIAS TAPE VERSION:

Contrasting machine thread for attaching bias binding

Fusible web to adhere bias tape to skirt front and back

Bias Binding Tape for all Sizes:

Color 1: 2 yards of 1/2" extra wide double fold bias tape (unfolds to 1 3/4" wide)

Color 2: 2 yards of 1/2" single fold bias tape (unfolds to 7/8" wide)

Color 3: 2 yards of 1/2" extra wide double fold bias tape (unfolds to 1 3/4" wide)

Color 4: 2 yards of 1/2" extra wide double fold bias tape (unfolds to 1 3/4" wide)

Color 5: 2 yards of 1/2" extra wide double fold bias tape (unfolds to 1 3/4" wide)

Hem embellishment trim: 3 yards of 1/2" extra wide double fold bias tape

Waist band trim: 3 yards of 7/8" double fold bias quilt binding

OR five coordinating pieces of fabric to make your own bias binding (yardage may vary due to cutting on the bias)

POCKET VERSION:

For all Sizes: 1/2 yard of contrasting fabric for pocket, waist band and hem trim.
