Yo-Yo Pincushions are as contemporary as they are retro! They are a charming addition to anyone's sewing room or studio. Use coordinating fat quarters or scraps from your fabric stash to create these little gems. It's also a great way to reconnect and get creative with great buttons, beads and threads!

## **FINISHED SIZES (approximate):**

Large Rick Rack - 4 1/2" dia.

Small Rick Rack - 4" dia.

Large Pom Pom - 7 1/4" dia.

Small Pom Pom - 6" dia. x 3" (not shown on cover)

Large Yo-Yo Covered - 6" dia.

Small Yo-Yo Covered - 4 1/2" dia. x 2 1/4" (not shown on cover)

Stuffed Yo-Yo with Small Puff - 5 1/4" dia.

## **MISCELLANEOUS MATERIALS NEEDED:**

*Refer to Assembly Instructions for each individual pincushion for more specific materials needed.*

4 to 6 coordinating fat quarters or 10" x 10" square fabric scraps

Wright's jumbo and medium rick rack

Wright's mini pom pom trim

Assorted buttons and beads for embellishing

Polyester fill or wool roving for stuffing

Wool scraps for needle sharpening stuffing

Thread to match fabrics

Sewing needle

Embroidery floss in contrasting colors

Embroidery needle
